# Foreign Language Enrollments in Public Secondary Schools, Fall 2000 Summary Report

Foreign language enrollments have increased slightly over the last several years, according to the eighteenth in a series of surveys conducted first by the Modern Language Association (1958-1970) and then by ACTFL (1974-present). The following report summarizes the responses received from a questionnaire sent to officials in each state and the District of Columbia. Forty-eight states responded; however, because not all states collect data, and some collect it in inconsistent formats, enrollments were estimated for several states in whole or in part. The survey was conducted pursuant to a grant from the U.S. Department of Education, International Research and Studies Program.

## **Summary of Results**

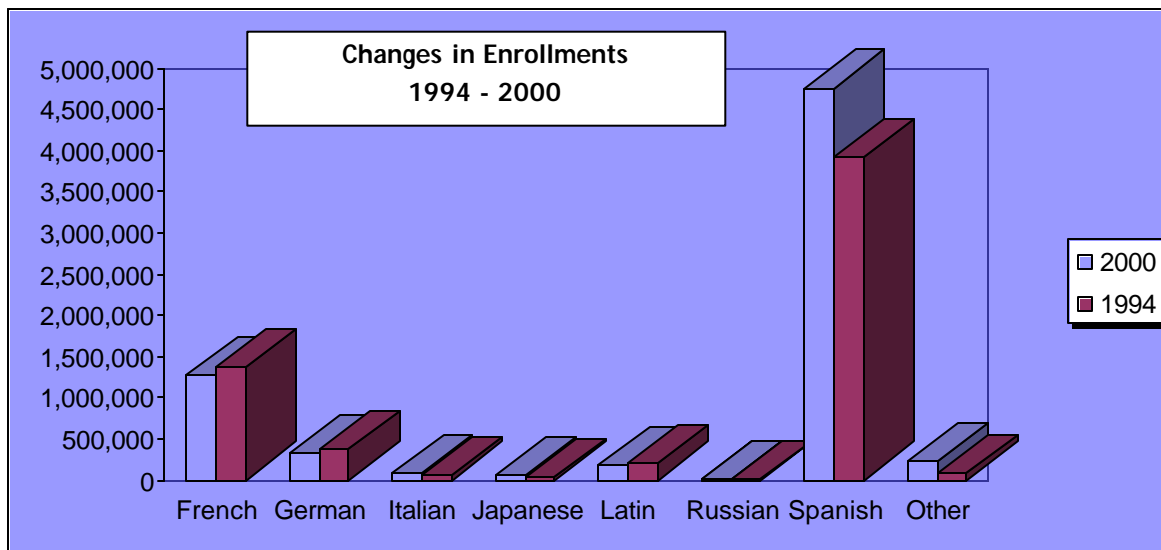
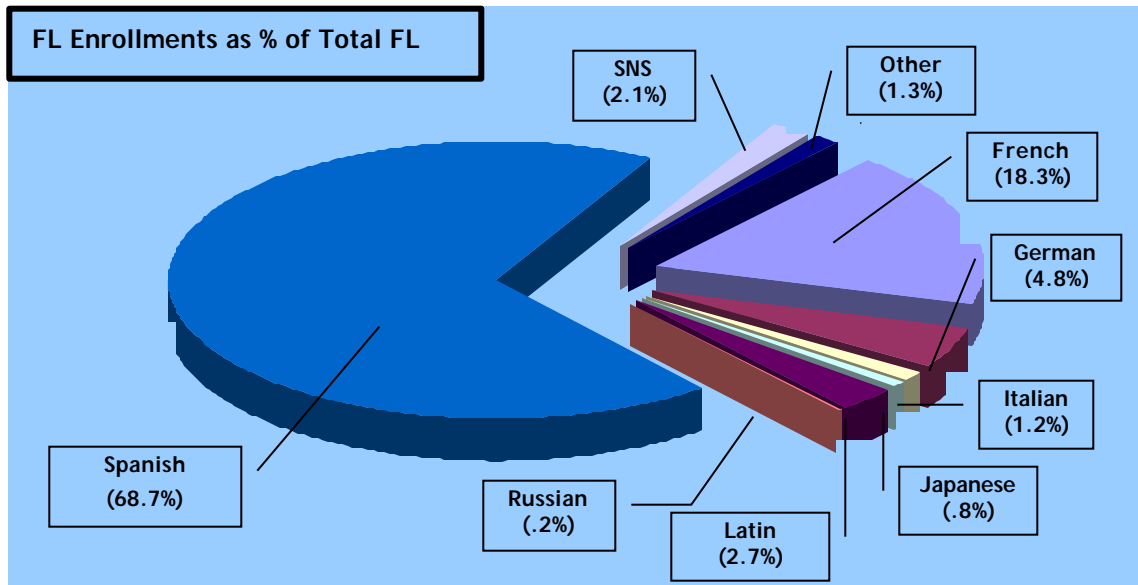
Almost seven million students in American public secondary schools were enrolled in foreign language courses in grades 7-12, representing 33.8% of total enrollment. In 1994, the last year in which enrollment data were examined, just over six million students were studying a second language, or 32.8% of the total public secondary school population. Looking at the high school level alone, just under six million students, 43.8%, were studying a foreign language in 2000, an increase of approximately 2% over 1994. A drop of slightly less than 2% occurred at the junior high school level, where 14.7% of students are enrolled in language study, compared with 16.2 in 1994. These changes may be accounted for by changes in data collection procedures at the state level: for example, some states that collected data at the junior high level in the past no longer do so.

As in the past two surveys, elementary school data was requested from those states that collect it. Of the 19 states reporting, 5% of students in grades K-6 are enrolled in non-exploratory foreign language courses, compared with 6.4% of students in 24 states reporting in 1994.

Spanish enrollments continue to dominate. Spanish continues to dominate language instruction in the United States, accounting for almost 70% (68.8) of all language enrollments in grades 7-12. The number of students studying Spanish jumped by over 800,000, marking an increase of about 3%. During the same period, most other languages either reduced enrollments or remained steady. French enrollments are down 1.3% over the prior survey; with German and Latin enrollments down by less than one percent. Italian was the one bright spot of the non-Spanish languages. Enrollments were up by 22,000 students, a 38% increase over the prior survey, and the first measurable increase in the percentage of high school students studying Italian in 20 years.

The decreasing availability of enrollment data at the state level has also reduced the ability to determine the overall health of individual languages. For instance, Japanese and Russian enrollments have traditionally been strongest in the Pacific Northwest, but neither Alaska, Oregon, nor Washington were able to provide enrollment data for this year's survey. Similarly, pre-collegiate enrollments in Arabic were previously reported in only two states: California and Michigan, with the largest enrollments in Michigan. California did not break out its less commonly taught language enrollments as it has in the past, and Michigan had no data.

No changes in length of study. Despite the advent of national standards, calls to begin study in the lower grade levels, and a national climate that would tend to support more study of second languages and cultures, there remains no appreciable difference in the numbers of students studying beyond introductory language levels. In fact, percentages in the earlier grade levels have dropped. However, this analysis is hindered by the collection of data in a snapshot format. We still are unable to determine how many students are switching languages, study more than one language simultaneously, or are taking one language continuously throughout their pre-collegiate education. We also have no way of knowing what students are actually capable of doing as a result of their language study. A survey that examined this type of information would be extremely valuable.



**Conclusions**

The increasing difficulty in gathering foreign language enrollment data at the state level makes it more and more difficult to garner anything but cursory information on the status of foreign language education in this country. One item worthy of mention is that, with the increasing dominance of Spanish, it will become incumbent on the foreign language profession to work with educators and policymakers to develop programs that will move students of Spanish into the study of other languages.

It is evident by the great number of students studying foreign languages in the United States that tracking student enrollment in foreign language courses is imperative. In order to expand and improve the teaching of foreign languages in the United States, enrollment statistics must be made available to enable the U.S. Department of Education, state departments of education, local boards of education, and policy makers to appropriate funds and resources accordingly.
