_	Provides evidence of interpretive, interpersonal, and presentational elements in that unit;
-	Reflects on the effectiveness of the lesson in the video, including the use of the target language, as well as the next steps.

	Reflection on student work - maximum of four (4) pages providing a written reflection about these two student examples and how they:
-	Demonstrate current best practices of language teaching and learning to include the integration of the World-Readiness Standards for Learning Languages (5 Cs);

-	Provides the effective use of feedback including, but not limited to, rubrics.
